Product Name & Description	AZO® Urinary Pain Relief Maximum Strength or Regular Strength
Indications	Targeted relief from urinary pain, burning, urgency and frequency associated with urinary tract infections. AZO® Urinary Pain Relief provides only symptom relief and should be used as directed on the package.
Active Ingredient	Phenazopyridine Hydrochloride, a urinary analgesic
Clinical Trials	Two randomized, controlled trials have demonstrated Phenazopyridine HCl significantly relieves symptoms and discomfort of urinary tract infections. ^{1,2}
Mechanism of Action	Phenazopyridine HCl is excreted in the urine (65% of the oral dosage is chemically unchanged) where it exerts a topical analgesic effect on the mucosa of the urinary tract. ^{3,4} The benefits are provided within 1 hour, the time in which Phenazopyridine HCl reaches the bladder as indicated by a change in urine color. ⁵
Dosage and Administration	99.5mg (Maximum Strength) or 95mg (Regular Strength) Phenazopyridine HCl per tablet Take two (2) tablets, three (3) times daily with or after meals as needed for up to two (2) days.
